

حرف عطف أم و أو

Harf A'taf Um and Aoo

أم حرف عطف : Harf A'taf

If in a sentence two things are mentioned and it is not sure whether this or that then in Arabic language then to ask about the two أم is used between them and the first one occurs after Hamzah Istifhaam . Literal meaning of Harf A'taf أم is (OR)

Besides interrogative sentence, Um أم is used in several other ways.

﴿إِنَّ الَّذِينَ كَفَرُوا سَوَاءٌ عَلَيْهِمْ أُنزِرَتْهُمْ أَمْ لَمْ تُنزِرْهُمْ لَا يُؤْمِنُونَ﴾ (2:6)

Indeed, those who disbelieve - it is all the same for them whether you warn them or do not warn them - they will not believe.

حرف عطف أو: Harf A'taf أو In a non-interrogative sentence Harf A'taf أو is used for the same meaning like أم.

﴿رَبَّنَا لَا تُؤَاخِذْنَا إِنْ نَسِينَا أَوْ أَخْطَأْنَا﴾ (2:286)

Our Lord, do not impose blame upon us if we have forgotten or erred.
